

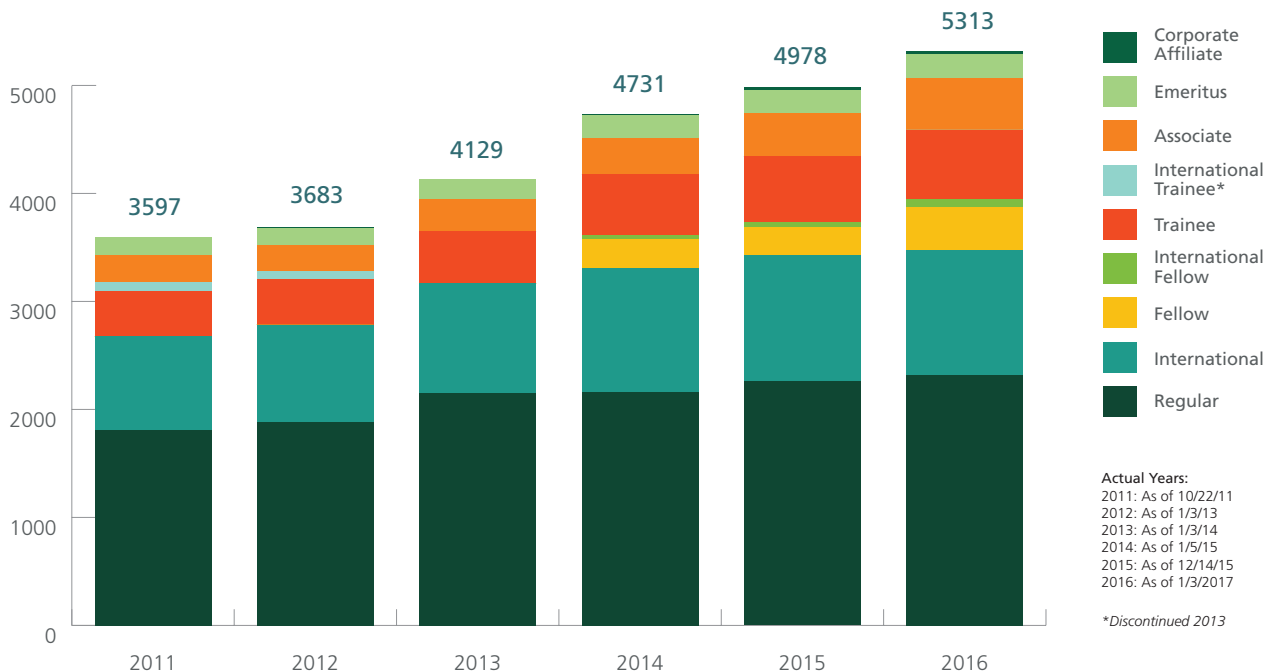

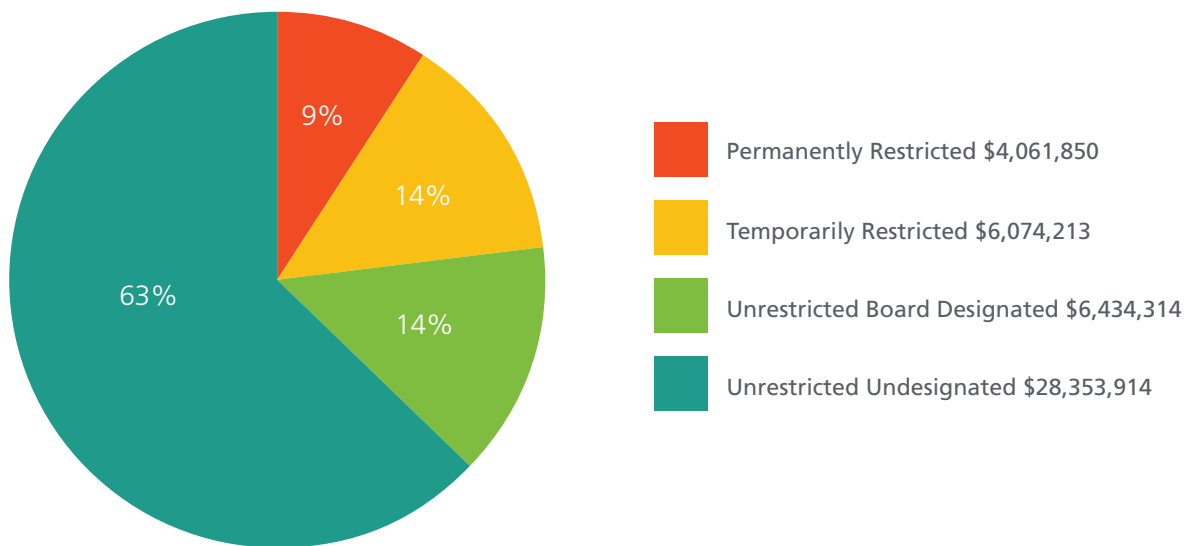

FY2016 Combined Net Assets

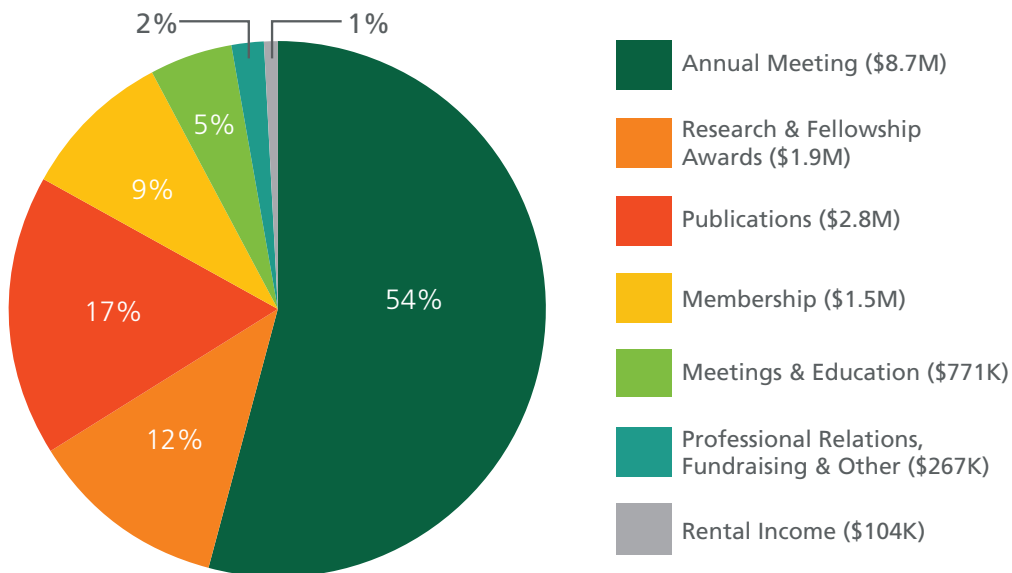


FY2016 Combined Revenue & Expenses

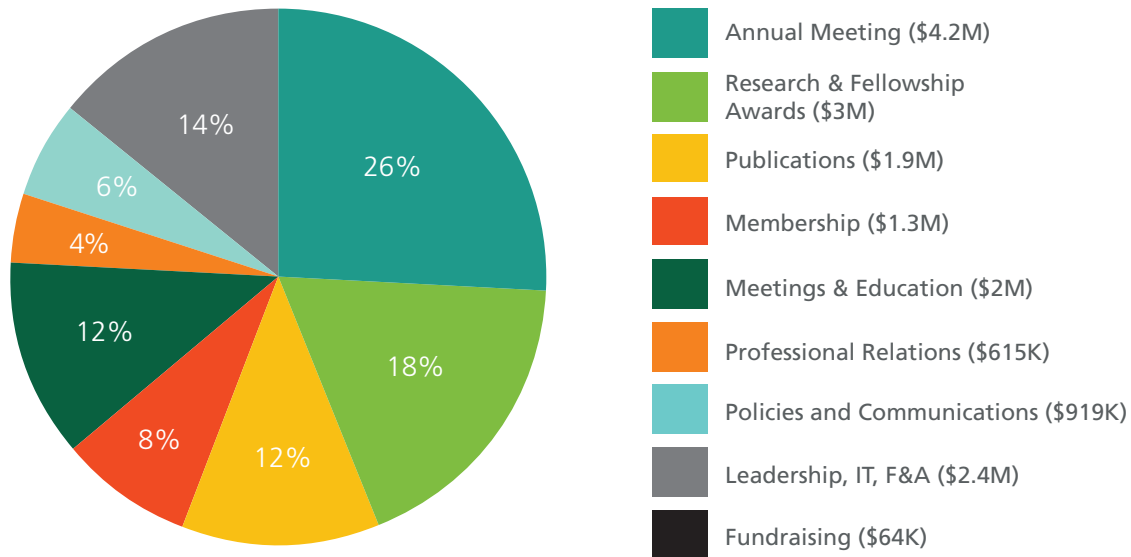
