

Seeking Editor for HEPATOLOGY

The American Association for the Study of Liver Diseases (AASLD) is seeking an editor for HEPATOLOGY. Candidates for the position should:

- Be well-established and well-respected in academic hepatology, with a high profile in the field
- Have a broad understanding of basic and clinical research in the field
- Be experienced in editorial decision making
- Be highly skilled in editing and writing
- Be an AASLD regular or emeritus member (North American resident) throughout the complete tenure

The term will be January 2012 through December 2016, however the Editor should have an Editorial Board in place by July 1, 2011, at which time he or she will start to receive and review manuscripts. Manuscript processing has been and will continue to be through the AASLD central office in Alexandria, Virginia.

Each candidate should submit by **April 16, 2010**:

- A curriculum vitae
- Letters of support from the Dean and Department Chair of his or her academic affiliation
- A detailed statement outlining a vision for the immediate future of HEPATOLOGY and strategic plan to accomplish these goals
- A PROPOSED roster of Associate Editors

The selection committee will review applications and will meet with four finalists in September 2010, as part of the final selection process.
