

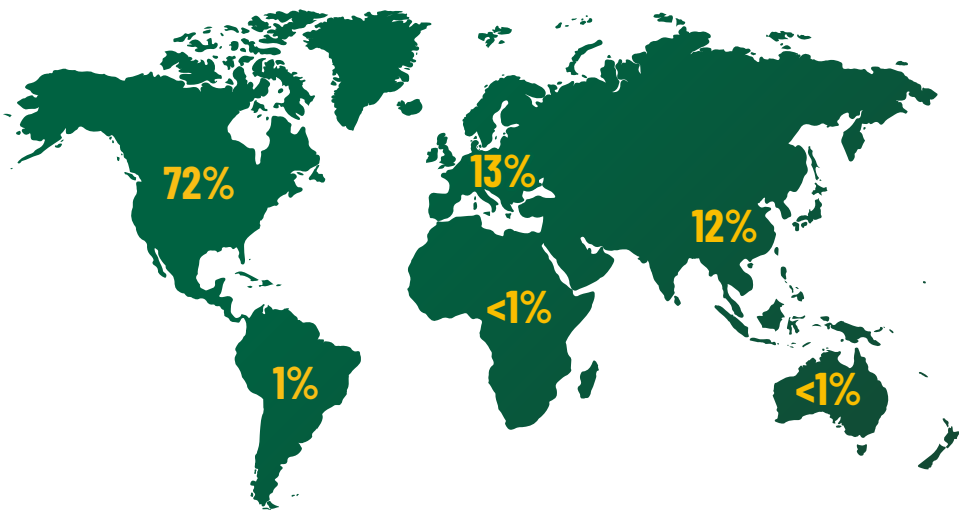

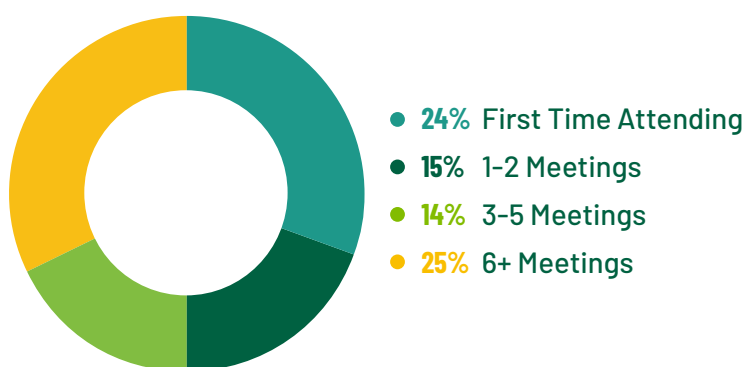

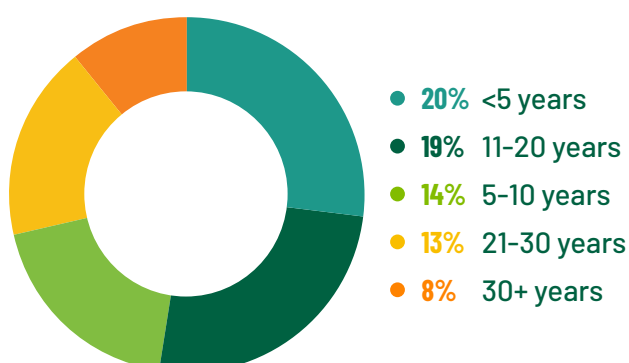
### YEARS OF TLM ATTENDANCE\*



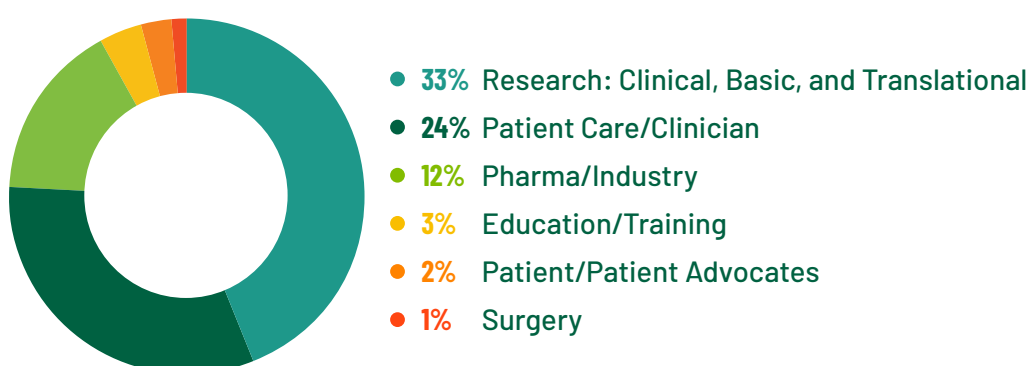
